

# USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

EXCEPT WHEN MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

- **Dropping Zones:** As an additional option to the Rule for Penalty Area relief (Rule 17.1d), on holes 4, 13 and 14, dropping zones are rectangular areas two club-lengths in depth, the front and sides of which are defined by the outside limits of two blue tee markers. (Reference Local Rule E-1 of The Official Guide to the Rules of Golf.)
- **Elk Damage:** In the General Area, damage caused by elk is treated as Ground Under Repair from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1b (interference does not exist if the damage only interferes with the player's stance). (Reference Local Rule F-10 of The Official Guide to the Rules of Golf.)
- **Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Greens:** For a ball in the General Area, if an Immovable Obstruction (e.g., a sprinkler head) is on the line of play and within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball, relief may be taken under Rule 16.1b. (Reference Local Rule F-5 of The Official Guide to the Rules of Golf.)
- **E-5 Alternative to Stroke and Distance for a Ball Lost in the General Area:** Under penalty of two strokes, golfers have the option to drop a ball in the vicinity of where the lost ball is estimated to have come to rest on the course. The drop must be made no closer to the hole than this estimated spot and may be in the nearest fairway, within two club-lengths of its edge.
- Golf Course is Irrigated with Reclaimed Water
