

across the community, but they've also been confirmed by our Security Team, which recently completed its audit of Zone 5, all Meadow homes, and proudly reported a 77% pass rate, one of the highest initial marks we've seen to date. Your efforts to clear fuels, clean up lots, and create defensible space around structures are making a meaningful difference. Please note that July will be the final month for complimentary pine needle pickup for 2025. Beginning in August, charges will apply for this service. If you haven't yet completed your Firewise compliance, now is the time to reach out to our Concierge to support.

We all want to preserve the fun and relaxed "summer camp" atmosphere that defines Forest Highlands, especially your Board and our operations team. That said, the Board's mission reminds us, it is their responsibility to "provide for the safety and comfort of our members to the greatest

extent possible and reasonable." Safety and accountability go hand in hand with our community's overall liability, and we must all do our part.

I raise this sensitive topic of community safety because we've received thoughtful feedback from a broad range of members regarding concerns about road conduct in our community, particularly when it comes to honoring our Code of Conduct and Rules of the Road. Our Board and Security Committee are monitoring this closely and utilizing data from our Security Team's proactive patrols to guide the appropriate next steps.

I also want to recognize you, our members for your continued patience as our agronomy team works hard to bring the golf courses back to peak conditions following an unprecedentedly dry winter. Director of Agronomy Bill Abbey and his team are doing everything possible to expedite the grow-in process and ensure that both golf courses meet the high standards we all expect and enjoy. Your understanding and support during this recovery period mean a great deal to our team.

As we prepare to celebrate the 4th of July holiday, a signature weekend of participation here at Forest Highlands, I want to thank you all in advance for doing your part to make it another safe, festive, and memorable experience for everyone. Our team has been working tirelessly to prepare, and we look forward to delivering the sophisticated fun that defines our community.

Looking ahead to 2026, our Board of Directors is currently assembling the Nominating Committee for next year's Board elections. This time-honored tradition plays a vital role in ensuring we remain aligned with our future strategy and core values. Serious candidates who complete the required orientation prior to the official election opening will have an opportunity to present their campaign messages to the community during the Annual Town Hall Meeting. DINING ALERTS

To stay current on dining activities, join the Dining Department on Clubster for the latest menus and event updates.

DRESS GUIDELINES

The following is **NEVER** acceptable in any area of the clubhouses, any time of day or night:

• Exposed midriff, halter tops, strapless/tube tops, cropped tops, cutoffs shorts, gym shorts, bib overalls, coveralls, sweatpants with rips, swimsuits, muscle/cut-offs shirts, sports bras, t-shirts with rips, or that contain profanity.

CANYON DINING DRESS GUIDELINES:

New this year, shorts are NOT permitted in the Canyon Dining Room any day of the week.

- The Main Dining Room guidelines:-For evening dining, the dress code is defined as "country club casual."
- Jeans and Denim pants are acceptable for men and women but must adhere to our denim guidelines.
- Collared shirts are mandatory for all men; golf, short sleeve or long sleeve collared shirts are all permissible.
- Hats, visors, and shorts of any kind are not permissible.

THE CANYON PATIO, LOUNGE OR COOLDOWN GUIDELINES

- Hats may be worn by men or women. All hats and visors should be worn with the bill facing forward.
- Athleisure, shorts, t-shirts that meet our t-shirt requirements are acceptable

MEADOW DINING ROOM DRESS GUIDELINES:

- Hats may be worn by men and women in all areas of the Meadow Clubhouse during the day or evening, but all hats and visors need to be worn with the bill facing forward.
- T-Shirts that meet our t-shirt requirements are permitted
- Twill shorts and jeans that meet our jean requirement are permitted at the Meadow Clubhouse.
- Athleisure is permitted as defined by our athleisure guidelines.

Members are expected to inform their spouses, dependents and guests of the dress requirements prior to entering any part of the Club. Management is directed by the Board of Directors to refuse service to persons who do not conform to the Dress Code.

MEET CHEF ODAIN GAYLE

Hello Forest Highlands, my name is Odain Gayle. I am Jamaican by birth but a citizen of the world. I am a Seasonal Temporary H2B Employee here at Forest Highlands Golf Club.

I am now in my Sixth (6th) season at Forest Highlands Golf Club. My journey first started here in May of 2020 as an Advanced Cook amid the pandemic at the Canyon Club House, and I have been loving it here ever since. It's a great club to work at; it feels like home away from home. I now return in 2025 as the Special Events & Catering Chef ready to hit the road, creating culinary magic in the homes of Gourmands and Bon Vivants here at Forest Highlands Golf Club.

I first arrived in the United States in 2008 on a F-1 student visa where I studied at the Hocking College Culinary Institute in Nelsonville, Ohio where I graduated with an associate's degree in culinary arts (2010). After completing my optional practical training, I went back home to pursue my bachelor's degree in Hospitality Tourism and Hotel Management (2014).

During my studies here in the United States I entered numerous culinary competitions that took me across several states competing in various culinary competitions. I was the Captain of the American Culinary Federation Hocking College Hot Food Team in Columbus, Ohio earning numerous awards including a gold medal as State Champions (2010), a silver medal as runners up in the Regional Competition (2010) and a bronze medal 3rd place State Competition (2011). I also entered competitions back in my home country of Jamaica where I was also voted the Top Culinary Instructor (2012) in Jamaica by the "Taste of Jamaica" Competition hosted by the Culinary Federation of Jamaica and Top Tertiary/Vocational Team of the Year (2012) where I led the team to victory as the Kitchen Manager also earning two Gold Medals.

In my spare time, I enjoy watching football (soccer), going fishing, traveling/ sightseeing and bowling. I have visited 24 States in the U.S so far and plan to visit more in the future.

- Delivery can be arranged by calling the Canyon. Delivery fee is \$10 per case.



Plan submittals are required to have a digital copy (PDF). Digital copies can be sent to **designreview@fhgc.com**

SMALL PROJECTS

Smaller projects such as landscaping, re-paints, dog runs, minor additions and other minor changes can be reviewed weekly by the DRC, typically on Tuesdays.

Please note it is important members follow the steps of the Design Review Process, including submission of required applications as found on our member website. This is a proven and streamlined process provided the owner performs per the Development Standards for any exterior alterations to the owner's property including projects such as:

- 1. Roof Replacements
- 2. Exterior Painting
- 3. Deck Projects
- Dog Runs
- 5. Landscaping
- 6. Driveways

Once the new aggregate was in place, the team swept the roads, ensuring that all debris was cleared and leaving our roads looking fresh and clean for residents and visitors alike.

Dear Members,

Each year, Forest Highlands is required to compile and provide a water quality report to homeowners. All of the water at Forest Highlands comes from ten deep wells that range between 1,200 feet to 1,600 feet. Your drinking water is supplied from eight of those wells. The wells were drilled through several layers of limestone, sandstone and other geologic formations to reach the Coconino aquifer.



MIDGE FLIES & MOSQUITOS

Midge flies and mosquitoes are a common occurrence in forest settings like Forest Highlands. The midges are small flying insects, similar to a mosquito, but do not bite. They will swarm and follow you like a shadow and that can be quite annoying. Mosquitoes, well, we all know how much fun those can be.

The Utility Department treats the Kachina Wetland ponds for midge flies and mosquitos with larvae growth regulators and goldfish. Golf Course Maintenance has a program to treat low, wet areas on the golf courses. While those treatments help reduce the amount of these insects within the community, it certainly can't get to them all.



Here are some tips to help control the nuisance populations on your property -

- Remove Habitats by eliminating standing water. Empty and change out water in bird baths, pet water bowl, fountains, wading pools and potted plant trays at least once a week to eliminate potential habitats.
- Use a repellent while enjoying the outdoors. There are many options from sprays, scents and electric devices to defend your space from the little invaders.



FRIENDLY REMINDER: CHECK YOUR MAIL & PARCEL LOCKERS

The USPS courier has informed us that all oversized parcel lockers are currently full, making it difficult to deliver new packages. We kindly ask that you check your mailbox and retrieve any packages from the oversized lockers as soon as possible.

BULKY TRASH & RECYCLING ITEMS

For members only, large items that do not fit in trash receptacles, there are dumpsters available at the Public Works yard. The hours are M-F from 7:00-3:00 and weekends from 8:00-1:00. Also, for members only, there are recycling bins located behind the Highlands Fire Station.

Remember to place recyclable items in the container and not next to it.

Please do not throw trash in dumpsters not belonging to or part of a home build or remodel on another property.

TRASH REMOVAL

Trash receptacles may not be over-filled, must close completely, and be wheeled to the end of the driveway no earlier than 24 hours prior to pick up on Monday mornings. Members found to have over-filled trash receptacles that result in scattered trash or have placed receptacles out earlier than the approved 24hours prior to pick up are subject to a fine. Members are responsible for their guests'/renters' compliance with this rule. Only the approved trash receptacles may be used. The trash receptacle will be wheeled back by the contractor's personnel.

SPEED LIMITS WITHIN FOREST HIGHLANDS

SPEED LIMIT ON FOREST HIGHLANDS DRIVE IS 25 MPH

As of December 1, 2024, the speed limit on Forest Highlands Drive was reduced from 35 MPH to 25 MPH. This change is part of our ongoing commitment to safety and our goal to foster a secure and comfortable environment for all community members and their guests. Enforcement began on December 1st 2024. Thank you for your attention to this and ensuring the safety of everyone within the community.

SPEED LIMITS

The speed limits on the roads at Forest Highlands are as follows:

- 10 MPH in the Clubhouse parking lots.
- 15 MPH through the Gate House access area, in or around the Mail room, on all roads in the Cottage developments, in all posted "Children Playing" and "Pedestrian" zones.
- 25 MPH on all main roads inside Forest Highlands.
- 25 MPH on Forest Highlands Drive between the Gate House & Mailroom.

Passing any motor vehicle on any of these roads is prohibited. For your safety these speed limits will be monitored by radar, including radar cameras and strictly enforced.

VEHICLE OPERATION WITHIN FOREST HIGHLANDS

Forest Highlands Golf Club 2025 Rules, Information, & Fees rule 3.3 Vehicles states:

- All vehicles must be insured for liability and property damage.
- All drivers operating a vehicle within Forest Highlands must have a valid state driver's license.
- Occupants of a vehicle must comply with seatbelt laws required by the State of Arizona and as recommended by the vehicle manufacturer.
- Vehicle use on golf courses, cart paths, walking paths or common areas other than roads is strictly prohibited. This includes the paths behind the Meadow and Canyon Clubhouses.



BICYCLE, E-BIKE & SCOOTER SAFETY

Remember to follow safe riding practices when cruising through the community!

Electric bicycles, seated scooters, and stand-up scooters are allowed within Forest Highlands. These vehicles do not require state licensing or insurance and must follow Arizona's road rules.

Important Restriction: Electric bicycles without pedals are considered motorcycles by law and are not permitted within Forest Highlands, except for ingress and egress to a lot if licensed for public road use. Riders aged 14 and under must wear a helmet. Electric bicycles and scooters are not allowed on sidewalks and may only be used on cart paths before and after golfing hours. Seated Scooters: These vehicles require a licensed driver, and only one rider per seat is allowed unless designed as a two-seater. Stand-up Scooters: These scooters must adhere to Arizona's road laws and community quidelines.

Please refrain from practicing unsafe riding behaviors while on the roads of the community. Thank you!



LEASH UP & CLEAN UP!

Rules of Forest Highlands require dogs to be on a leash; this rule is consistent with the Coconino County Leash laws. Violations of the leash rule/law could lead to a Forest Highlands fine and on a more significant level, Coconino County Animal Control could cite dog owners and county violations would result in a larger fine.

REMINDER, dogs are not allowed on the golf courses, dogs are not allowed off leash in recreational areas such as all parks and when outside of the property owners lot unless you are within the boundaries of the dog park located off Andrew Douglas and please clean up after your pets immediately.

FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Stage 2 Fire Restrictions began on Wednesday 6/18/2025

During Stage 2 igniting, building, maintaining, or using a fire fueled by combustible materials such as wood, charcoal, briquettes, and/or coal is strictly prohibited, except within a developed site. Smoking is also prohibited, except within an enclosed vehicle or a developed site. Additional prohibitions include the use of internal combustion engines for common household-only activities, such as landscaping or property maintenance and repair unless they are equipped with a spark arresting device. Stage 2 also prohibits welding and/or the use of acetylene or other torch with an open flame. The use of tracer or incendiary rounds of ammunition or explosive targets is also strictly prohibited.

Using a device that is solely fueled by pressurized liquid petroleum or LPG fuels that can be turned on and off is allowed only in a developed site. A developed site is defined in the County's Wildfire Defense Ordinance as an area that is barren or cleared of all overhead and surrounding vegetation and combustible materials within a 15-foot radius of the device.

FIREWISE INSPECTIONS 2025 & SUGGESTED ITEMS FOR ALL MEMBERS TO FOCUS ON

During the 2025 season the entire community is strongly encouraged to participate in maintaining defensible spaces for their lots and bring them into compliance with Firewise standards. The results of proactively complying with Firewise standards this season will further mitigate fire risk for the entire community and is suggested due to the dry winter conditions our region suffered this winter.

Lots outside of zone 5 will not receive a pass of fail rating. However, if you have completed the Firewise Safety Check form and wish to have a Firewise certified officer inspect your lot please contact Security to schedule an appointment to have it inspected.

In 2025 the assigned Firewise zone for Forest Highlands is Zone 5 (made up of lots: 701-872). Firewise Safety Checks of the noted lots have been completed, and you should have already received an email either passing the property or detailing items needing attention.

All Forest Highlands residents are encouraged to make/keep their lot(s) safe. *Below are a few suggestions in maintaining a Firewise Defensible Space on your lot(s)*:

- · Remove dead fuels from your property
- Remove dead standing trees and logs from the ground less than 16" in diameter
- · Remove dead shrubby materials
- Cut down dried grasses and flowers
- Remove needles, leaves, and branches from the ground, leaving an organic covering of approximately 2"
- Clear needles and leaves from roofs and gutters
- Store firewood at least 30' (if possible; minimum of 10') up-hill from your home
